FINANCIAL SUBSIDY FOR THE ASIAN MEDICAL STUDENTS' CONFERENCE 2009

1. Introduction

There are two types of financial subsidy available to students attending the Asian Medical Students' Association Conference 2009:

- a. Dr. Li Shu Pui Centenary Travel Scholarship
- b. College subsidy/university grant (please seek details from college/faculty)

This document outlines the regulations and application procedures regarding the Dr. Li Shu Pui Centenary Travel Scholarship managed by the Asian Medical Students' Association Hong Kong.

2. Eligibility Criteria

Candidates should be

- a. an undergraduate enrolled in the MBBS or MBChB programme at The University of Hong Kong and The Chinese University of Hong Kong respectively
- b. be accepted as a delegate for the Asian Medical Students' Conference 2009

3. Details of Dr. Li Shu Pui Centenary Travel Scholarship

- a. There will be a total of 4 scholarship awards; 2 for each University.
- b. The amount awarded will be HK\$2, 500 each
- c. Applicants will be selected by an independent Selection Committee formed by representatives from the Dr. Dr. Ellen Li Charitable Foundation based on the following selection criteria:
 - i. Financial need (40%)
 - ii. Academic performance in university and/or last public exam result (30%)
 - iii. Participation in extra-curricular activities in University. (30%)
- d. Candidates will not be interviewed, and the decisions of the Selection Committee are final.

4. Application Procedures

Application forms and guidelines can be downloaded from the website www.amsahk.org. Applicants should submit the completed application in a sealed envelope clearly stating "**Application for Dr. Li Shu Pui Centenary Travel Scholarship 2009**", on or before the application deadline of **13th March 2009 (Friday)** together with relevant supporting documents.

5. Method of Submission:

Applications should be submitted by

- a. Hand to any AMSAHK Executive Committee member or
- b. Mail to P.O. Box 6176, Central Post Office, Hong Kong

[For applicants by mail: Date of postmark will be regarded as date of submission. Applicants should send a confirmation email to Ms. Stephanie Yu: stephanie.yu@amsahk.org].

6. Conditions of Award

Successful candidates will receive a one-off grant. They will still enjoy college subsidy if available, but will not receive any other subsidy given by the Asian Medical Students' Association Hong Kong. Award of the subsidy is subject to satisfactory participation of the delegate in activities prior to and after the Conference. This includes

- a. A minimum of 80% attendance at all pre- and post- conference events organized by AMSAHK
- b. Submission of Post-Conference Report within 2 weeks after the AMSC

Failure to fulfill the above criteria will result in cancellation of the grant. Any change in results will be announced in August 2009.



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7. Notification of results

Successful delegates will be informed by AMSAHK in early April.

8. Handling of Information and Personal Data supplied in application

All personal data provided will be used solely for activities relating to the selection process for this Scholarship scheme and the compilation of relevant statistics to facilitate reviews of the award scheme.

In accordance with Sections 18 and 22 and Principle 6 of Schedule 1 of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, candidates have the rights to request access to and to request the correction of the data provided subject to payment of the necessary administrative charges.
